We will - Offer both online and in person parent/carer consultations

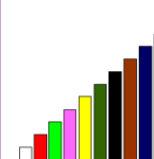
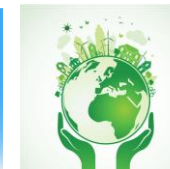
You Said - You want to come into school for events
